Medicine Wheel Garden

BLUECampanula rotudifolia (Harebell)



Leaf: Basal leaves are generaly entire, hairless, and ovate to heart shaped. Stem leaves are long ($^{\sim}$ 8 cm), entire, stalkless, and almost linear.

Plant height: 15 to 45 cm tall

• Flowers/Fruit: Bell-shaped blue or purple flowers with five pointed lobes at the tips of each flower. Fruit is a hanging capsule 0.5 to 2 cm long that ripens from green to brown.

Flowering period: June to September (Mid)

Water: MediumOntario native: Yes

• Attracts: bees and hummingbirds

• Other notes: Perennial

Nepeta racemose (Catmint)



• Leaf: Features gray-green, hairy, **ovate** leaves (to 1" long) with prominent veining and heart-shaped bases. Leaves are highly fragrant when crushed or bruised.

• Plant height: 60 to 90 cm tall

• Flowers/Fruit: Pale to deep violet two lipped flowers.

• Flowering period: May to September (Full)

Water: Dry to mediumOntario native: No

Attracts: Butterflies and hummingbirds

Penstemon hirsutus (Hairy Beardtongue)







• Leaf: Basal leaves are elliptic and stem leaves are lance-shaped to oblong.

• Plant height: 60 to 120 cm tall

• Flowers/Fruit: Pale blue, spike arranged tube flowers.

• Flowering period: April to June (Early Season)

Water: Dry to mediumOntario native: Yes

• Attracts: Long-tongues bees and butterflies. Small Carpenter Bees, Mason Bees,

American Copper Butterfly

• Other notes: Perennial
