

# ANNUAL REPORT 2020- 2021



## Highlights of the Year



### Re-opening Davis Bike Hub

The Bike Hubs were closed from March - August 2020 due to COVID-19. A safety protocol was put in place and modified bike repairs were offered at the Davis campus starting end of September 2020. The bike rentals and repair services were made available from June 2021 onwards.

### Re-opening the HMC Bike Hub

The HMC Bike Hub was closed from March 2020 – August 2021. Beginning September 2021, COVID-19 restrictions have lessened, and the Bike Hub offered the bike rental and repair services again.



### Canada Healthy Communities Initiative

The Bike Hub was granted ~\$45,000 from the Canada Healthy Communities Initiative grant to continue program operations at both the Mississauga and Brampton locations. This included offering the Outdoor Public Bike Repair events that were opened to residents within Peel.

Sheridan's Cycling Coordinator (Vicki T.), the Mechanic (Peter B.), and Mission Zero Co-op Student (Kate S.) set up the Outdoor Public Repair station every week to fix peoples bikes.



There were amazing responses from the community with high praise on their overall experience using the service and feeling safe with the protocols in place. Some of their favourite parts of the experience were meeting the team to get their bike(s) tuned up, knowledgeability, and professional service offered. They enjoyed receiving cycling resources such as bike maps, lights, & bells, and learning more about their bike in the process since staff would explain the maintenance being done.



Ashutosh G., a paralegal student who used the rental program commented, "The Bike Hub program had a positively huge impact on me. It made me 10x more active during the summer and fall time. I was able to just pick up my bike go do the simplest things such as going to the gym at any hour, run to grab food or even go to the nearest movie theatre at any time without worrying that I might get late or I might not have a means of coming back home if I miss the last bus.



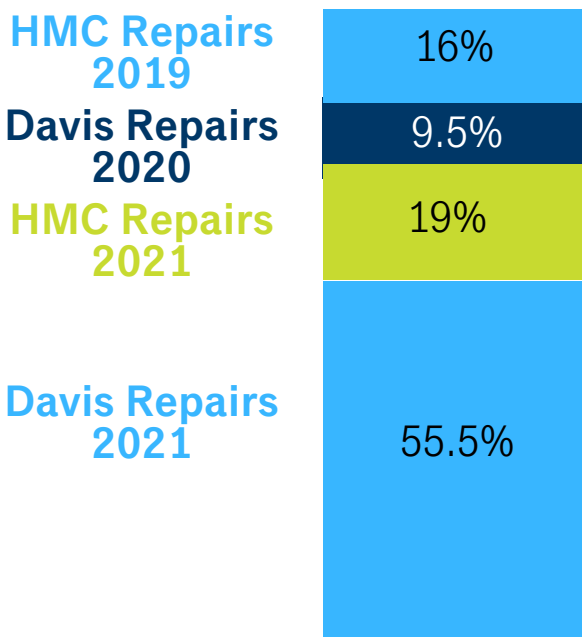
