## Highlights of the Year

### Region of Peel Support

Thank you to the Region of Peel for providing \$49,000 this year that allowed us to increase staffing and resources. We hired Jose and Karim as part-time mechanics to operate each shop from May - December. Each shop was opened 20 hours per week at the HMC and Davis Bike Hubs. The remainder of the funds not used this year is reserved for future Bike Hub operational costs.



### Service Updates

With the available capacity at each of the shops, the services were modified to increased to provide more flexibility to customers. The additional services added on were the basic bike repairs available to public members for a small fee, students/staff had access to daily bike rentals, and many bike workshops were hosted that were available to the public.




### Bike Events






## Davis & HMC By the numbers

- “It's a great resource with friendly and knowledgeable staff for someone like me who is new to bike riding.”





Do you have comments/feedback on how we can improve this program for 2026?

- “Maybe have more engagement, like having group rides.”
- “I think the bike hub needs to be advertised more to the general student body at Sheridan, Davis campus especially, most people don’t know about it. I work in student recruitment, and maybe for next year there can plan a tour route through the bike hub. that would be cool.”
- “I believe that more outreach and community centered events would help build a greater culture, connecting the Sheridan Bike Hub to the students, staff, faculty, and public that make up Mississauga. Within the space, it would be interesting to see guided repairs, giving the clients tools to perform common repairs and maintenance themselves, strengthening the cycling knowledge base.”
- “Advertise Tour de Sheridan earlier and everywhere. Start a Strava Group and/or friendly competition. Increase bike security on all 3 campuses.”
